What went through his mind as he watched the people greet Jesus with shouts of "Hosanna in the Highest" and then just days later see these same people cry out, "Crucify Him!" Walk with Bartimaeus as he sees the ugliness of humanity strip him of his Savior and then the glory of GOD extend the hand of forgiveness to the world.

Do not miss the opportunity to see and hear this eyewitness account of the last earthly days of the Messiah. Bartimaeus was a human being like you and I, yet his encounter with Jesus Christ not only opened his eyes but it opened his heart and he was blessed.

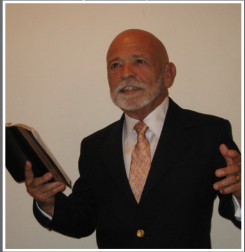
...there was not room for them in the inn. (Luke 2:7)

"Zacchaeus, hurry and come down, for I must stay at your house today."

So he hurried and came down and received him joyfully. And when they saw it, they all grumbled, "He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner." And Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, *"Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor. And if I have defrauded anyone of anything, I restore it fourfold."*

And Jesus said to him, *"Today salvation has come to this house, since he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."* (Luke 19:5-10 ESV) What is it like to be a despised and hated tax collector and yet be singled out to host the Son of God in your home?
